Now that the film has been completed I want you to know how much we appreciated your efforts in securing the cooperation of Professor Einstein. The picture is to be called "New Americans", and Professor Einstein's participation goes a long way toward making it a tremendously inspiring documentary recital of the story of the refugee in America.

The other Nobel prize winners graciously joined in the production. But, what is equally important, the film is the story of the adjustment of an average man to life in this new world. It will be released in mid December and it has already been booked in 10,000 theatres in the United States and will be seen by approximately 10,000,000 people. Spanish and Portuguese editions are now being booked in every country in South and Central America except the Argentine.

You were very kind, indeed, in helping us convince Professor Einstein of the project's value.
