


This is to request the amount of \$353.90 from my travel fund for the purpose of a trip from here to Berkeley and return.

Secondly, from Kopenhagen to Geneva where I worked for a short time in the lab of CERN. (My stay in Geneva was not paid by the people there.) Thirdly from Geneva back via Amsterdam.


The amounts are as follows:

As you know, I have already received a travel advance of \$650.00 - to cover inpart present expenses (\$500 - on 4/4/57 and \$150 - on 5/7/57).

I must also add that I can perhaps not claim the entire amount, as the sum of the expenses of this summer and the reimbursement for expenses to attend the Rochester Conference of last April slightly exceeds the \$1000 allowance (by \$8.24 if I am not mistaken).
