Dear Dr. La Balme,

Enclosed the list of people who I think should receive a copy of the brochure.

There are 16⁵ names in all. If the Institute could give me another 25 copies I should be grateful. There are a few people with whom I have been in correspondence because of the Nachlass of my husband's whose addresses I have in Toronto; there is also the possibility that it might be a good thing to have a few spare copies for Institutions or people who have been or will be helpful with the Andrew Alföldi Library.

When we last met you mentioned the possibility of a card being included, and I thought then this was not necessary. It occurred to me that it might be a good idea after all.

Could one draw something up that makes it clear that this comes from the Director of the IAS and from me?

Even though my list got longer than I had anticipated it still leaves quite a number of copies out of the 500 to be printed. 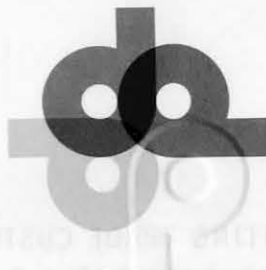
