Dear Ms Westergaard:

John Hunt has told me of his conversation with you. On the basis of that talk, I would like to set forth the terms of your association with the Institute.

- You will be engaged by the Institute as an indexer of the Minutes of Trustee meetings held from 1948 to the present. As you know, an index exists only for the Minutes of meetings held from the time of the Institute's founding in 1930 through 1947, and we wish to bring this index up to date.
- To that end, you will undertake whatever research in Institute records is required to ensure that the Minutes and their accompanying documents are complete.
- You will prepare an index for the Minutes of 1948 to the present, using a system compatible with that of the 1930-1947 file, and edit that material as necessary.
- You will alert Mr Hunt to any problems in the Minutes' binders--missing documents, damaged pages--that may arise as you work with the materials.
- By 1 June 1980, you will deliver a complete set of typed or legibly written index cards for the Trustee Minutes of meetings held from 1948 through April, 1980.
